Viera 55-and-over subdivisions are celebrating their communities this month, while making clear there's always room for more neighbors.

Lennar Homes invites potential home shoppers to attend the G'Day Gala open house today at the welcome center at Heritage Isle in Viera.

The 55-and-over community features villas priced from the high \$120,000 range and single-family homes with golf course views priced from the high \$100,000 range.

"We are serving up steaks and chicken on the barbie, Billy Tea in a keepsake cup, and giving away a free boomerang to our first 50 guests," said Mark Metheny, president of Lennar's Central Florida Division.

The 1,600-home Heritage Isle is adjacent to the Duran Golf Club and boasts a 21,000-square-foot clubhouse.

The facility features a heated swimming pool, fitness center with personal trainers and the Heritage Café, which serves breakfast, lunch and dinner five days a week for Heritage Isle residents and guests.

Indian River Colony Club, a 55-and-older community that caters to military personnel, marked its 25th anniversary with a residents' party last week. IRCC was the first subdivision in Viera to begin construction.
